






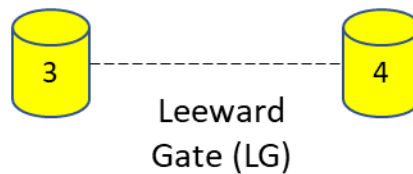
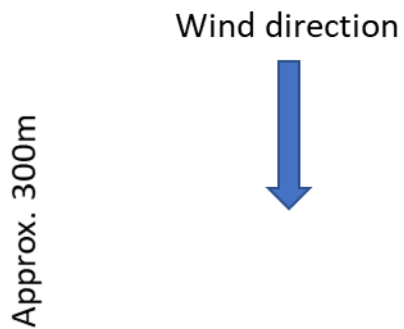


Minutes before starting signal	Visual Signal	Sound Signal	Meaning
-3	Class Flag, "1", "2", "3" 	1 Sound 	Warning and Preparatory Signal. The Preparatory Signal is deemed to be Code Flag U
-2	"3" Removed 	1 Sound 	Two minutes to Starting Signal
-1	"2" Removed 	1 Sound 	One minute to Starting Signal
Start	"1" and Class Flag removed	1 Sound 	Starting Signal



Upwind Course	Start (LG) – WG – LG – WG - Finish (LG)
Downwind Course	Start (WG) – LG – WG – LG – Finish (WG)
Start / Finish line: Leeward Gate (LG) or Windward Gate (WG) - Signal Vessel will be located at either extension of the Gate.

COURSES



Gates at the top AND bottom of our courses. Start/finish line uses either of these gates based on which gate is closer to shore/spectators/changeover dock. Thus subject to the wind direction we have either upwind or downwind starts.
